We have received a notification of **SCARLET FEVER** for a child in our school. This is very contagious and it is important that children are kept away from school until fully well. The symptoms present primarily with a bright red rash, fever, very sore throat (bacterial cousin to strep throat), swollen lymph nodes and nausea and vomiting. This needs to be treated with antibiotics so please ensure if your child presents with these symptoms, you visit your GP.
